Purpose

Key Responsibilities

- Support healthy Covenant Membership growth and engagement by:
 - Partnering with serve staff and other ministry areas to effectively promote and execute new member classes concurrently, across multiple campus
 - Ensuring detailed tracking of membership health metrics, follow-up, and discipleship as appropriate
 - Partner with Campus teams to ensuring ongoing member engagement
 - Equip campus teams to champion and intentionally disciple Covenant Membership
- Lead in planning, coordinating, and executing large scale events and programs, such as Discover Eleven22, in a multi-campus environment. Partner with other ministry areas from initial event design to post-event debrief and follow up.
- Intentionally engage in Connections Ministry events and environments (Connect Centers, Baptism, etc.) so as to help integrate Connections into the culture and life of the church.
- Support Connections Director and team as needed on big momentum events and other special projects.
