Purpose

This position is accountable for the leadership, development and execution of college ministry strategies and processes that will result in effective long-term missionaries sent in an environment where all people can discover and deepen a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Job Requirements and Experience

- Bachelor's Degree required
- 5+ years experience in student and college ministry to include teaching, overseeing group programming and curriculum, as well as college student engagement
- Strong leadership, highly relational, with a heart for global missions is highly desired.

Required Competencies and Skills

- Ability to develop priorities with the right balance of short and long-term wins
- Demonstrated ability to build effective organizational relationships/partnerships (internal and external)
- Ability to teach and shepherd staff/team, serve staff, and disciple group leaders
- Strong leadership abilities; sound judgment and above reproach character
- Demonstrated ability to effectively relate to college students, both male and female
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Strong computer skills; proficient in Microsoft Outlook, Word and Excel
- Ability to work with database information (CCB)

Key Responsibilities

- In partnership with Global Missions, develop an effective pipeline for college students to become long-term missionaries sent
- In partnership with Spiritual Formation, create missionally-aligned college disciple groups led by trusted adults beyond college age
- Develop and execute a plan for college students to engage in a few strategic, missionally-aligned, yearly experiences (conferences, serve days, mission trips etc.)
- Execute effective next steps for college students to take hold of their faith, takes next steps in their discipleship journey, and own the ministry at CoE22
- Partner with local colleges and universities to spiritually invest in local college students
- Create an environment that recruits, develops, leads and empowers college ministry serve staff and disciple group leaders that will impact the lives of college students
