- Support healthy baptism growth and engagement by:
 - Partnering with serve staff and other ministry areas to effectively lead, coordinate, promote and execute the baptism process concurrently across multiple campuses
 - Lead the coordination of baptism classes, participant tracking, participant follow-up and event logistics
 - Equip campus teams to champion and intentionally disciple those who are newly baptized
