ONE - WEEK 1:

HEART

THE POINT: In order for the church to be ONE so that the world knows we are His disciples we must forgive one another.

SERMON TEXTS: MARK 12:29-31, JOHN 17:20-26 AND MATTHEW 18:15-35

TEACHING & DIALOGUE

DISCOVER

Now that we discovered how God is moving through the Yeomans Family as part of the ONE discipleship journey, let's dig in together.

Have someone read Psalm 139:23-24 out loud.

- 1. Like King David in Psalm 139, Cary asks God to examine him. Have you ever asked God to examine you and your heart? What was the result? If you have not, what do you think God would find? (Asking God to examine you is a humbling exercise that truly declares He is the ONE thing that drives everything.)
- 2. Do you have people in your life that you can ask, "how am I doing" and humbly listen? (Share as you feel lead.)

DEEPEN


Now we have a chance to dive deeper into God's word

Have someone read John 17:20-26 out loud.

- 3. How has your relationship with Jesus grown over the last year? How about your relationships with other people? (Share as you feel lead.)
- 4. What does Jesus's prayer (John 17:20-26) reveal about God's desire for His church to be unified as ONE? Why is it important for the church to be unified? How is God calling you to be part of the answer to this prayer? (God's number one evangelistic strategy to reach the nations is the way that we, the church, loves one another.)
- 5. Do you trust that Jesus's blood forgave your entire sin debt or only a portion of it? How do you try to earn forgiveness for that portion of your debt? (Share as you feel lead.)
- 6. Are there parts of your life (past or present) that you still feel in debt to God? What relationship(s) do you need to reconcile so that God may be glorified and your heart may be sanctified before we continue on this journey? (Share as you feel lead.)

ACTION STEP

Take one more step by applying what you've learned to your life this week. Specifically looking at the debt ledger on pages 17-18 of the ONE: Loving God with All book, using the prayer (pg.18) to guide your time with the Lord this week. Ask: God, since I am forgiven, who do I need to forgive?
