# TEACHING & DIALOGUE

Video Segment 1:

## **DISCOVER**

Now that we discovered how God is moving through the Welch Family as part of the ONE discipleship journey, let's dig in together.

#### Have someone read Luke 7:15-23 out loud.

- 1. Ali Welch posed a powerful question, "God can heal, but does He have to?" Does God owe us an answer? A healing? A rescue? How did John the Baptist respond when he didn't receive the rescue he was expecting from Jesus? (No, God doesn't owe us any particular outcome or response, but He does make promises to us that offer help in every circumstance. John began to doubt Jesus when Jesus did not meet his preconceived expectations.)
- 2. Does it surprise you that the man who baptized Jesus would eventually begin to doubt Him? How did Jesus answer John and how can this equip us to process our physical and emotional needs from suffering with our soul level needs? (Share as you feel lead.)

#### **DEEPEN**

Now we have a chance to dive deeper into God's word.


#### Have someone read Luke 12:13-21 out loud.

- 3. Do you most naturally fall into the spender or saver category? How does the environment in which you grew up or what the world tells you today account for your tendency to either spend or save? (Share as you feel lead.)
- 4. Honestly think about how you use the resources God has given you. Are you a good steward? (Share as you feel lead and press into the "why" behind your answer.)
- 5. What stirs in you at the soul level when you read Luke 12:31-32? Is God the ONE thing that drives everything your life? What area of your life has not been turned over to Him? (Share as you feel lead.)
- 6. Identify where you are on the journey of generosity on page 11. How is God growing you in terms of generosity? (Share as you feel lead initial, consistent, intentional, surrendered or eternal.)

# **ACTION STEP**

Take one more step by applying what you've learned to your life this week. Go to coe22.com/ONE and take a quiz to see whether you are a saver or a spender. Understand your tendencies so together we may steward all we have been given to declare the Lord our God, the Lord is ONE!

Close out in prayer: Ask God for wisdom for your next step in ONE (page 22).
