## **TEACHING & DIALOGUE**

## **DISCOVER**

Now that we discovered how God is moving through the Kramer Family as part of the ONE discipleship journey, let's dig in together.

#### Have someone read Hebrews 12:1-2 and Acts 20:24 out loud.

- 1. The Kramer's message is very moving in how we learn that a "no" from God isn't always a negative. They had to start up a school for special needs students when there was no other option for their four special needs children. What sacrifices is our God calling you to make since there is obviously no other option? (Remember, faith is about obedience. Pastor Joby said in a sermon a while back that "The only thing worse than not following God's will for you is wishing that you had." Often, we have no idea what God may have in store for us on the other side of obedience.)
- 2. Reflecting on Hebrews 12:1-2, we learn from Jesus the ultimate sacrifice of running the race with endurance He endured the cross. He did that for us. How is God calling you specifically to finish strong? How can you envision that step of faith impacting your future in this life? (Share as you feel lead. Think about discussing the effort, determination and commitment that it will take to finish strong. Encourage those in your group, reminding them that God is calling us to find joy in our endurance.)

## (Play Video)

### Video Segment 2:

Point: Our enemy, the Devil, is the Father of Lies. Do not believe the whispers, but stand on the truth of the word of God. "It is written..."

### (Pause Video)

#### **DEEPEN**

Now we have a chance to dive deeper into God's word.

Have someone read Romans 12:1-2 and John 8:44 out loud.

- 3. What worldly things do you worship? Do you seek satisfaction from something that provides physical pleasure (desires of the flesh), want what others have (desires of the eyes) or desire to be recognized for your achievements and possessions (the pride of life)?
- 4. How is transformation of your mind essential to understanding God's will for your life? Over the last year, how has your mind been transformed by the truth of God? What have you learned about what God wants for you (His will) through this renewal? (Share as you feel lead.)
- 5. How do you need to grow in your understanding of God's mercy and grace in order to understand His will for your life? (Answers will vary.)
- 6. Do you trust God's acceptance of you through His mercy and grace? Are you therefore able to choose not to conform to the world, but instead choose to be a living sacrifice? What in your life needs to be sacrificed? (Share as you feel lead.)

## **ACTION STEP**


Take ONE more step by applying what you've learned to your life this week.

We have the power to take our thoughts captive. We have the power to control what we think about. We can intentionally stop listening to the lies of the Enemy and start listening to what God says about who He is and who we are.

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. – Philippians 4:8
